Best Poster Prize

Three prizes, as well as certificates, will be awarded to the best posters. The winning posters will be chosen by a panel of referees. A time window will be set for conversations between the referees and the presenters next to the posters. Presenters are also required to stand next to their poster board(s) for the purposes of informal discussion during the designated Coffee Breaks.

Please Note: The official language of the meeting is English and all presentations must be delivered in English only. All poster presenters must register for the full conference.

All abstracts will be published in the abstract supplement given to all conference participants. Presenters are expected to print, bring, and mount their own posters. Upon arrival, please introduce yourself as a poster presenter at the registration desk.

Posters should be mounted on the morning of March 13, 2023. A production assistant will be available to assist you between 7:45-8:30 AM. Please note that all posters must be removed by 4:30 PM on March 13. All presenters must take full responsibility for their own posters. The organizers are not responsible for posters that have not been removed by the end of the conference.

Preparation of Posters: Please prepare your poster on a single sheet of cardboard or laminated paper. The dimensions of the poster board are: 100 cm (W) x 230 cm (L). The recommended size for your poster is 60 cm (W) x 90 cm (L). Please note that presenters are strongly advised to refrain from preparing any poster larger than 90 cm (W) x 120 cm (L).

The title of the poster should describe the focus of the work. Allocate the top of the poster to the title (size 48, centered, bold, Times New Roman) and authors (size 36, centered, bold, Times New Roman) as stated in the submitted abstract. All authors and co-authors' full first and family name(s) are required. Affiliation details of all authors (department, institution, city, country) are required (size 24, centered, italic, Times New Roman). The presenting author must be listed as the first author, and the presenting author's contact details must be included (size 24, centered, italic, Times New Roman). The text, illustrations, etc., should be large and clear enough to be read from a distance of two meters.

Content: The poster presentation should cover all key aspects of the work and contain the following items, where applicable:

Abstract: A summary of your presentation. The abstract should include a description of the problem, the methods used for its solution, and major results and conclusions. The abstract is limited to 250 words (size 24, justified, normal, Times New Roman).

Keywords: Immediately after the abstract. Please provide between three and six keywords.

Introduction

Materials and Methods

Results

Discussion

Conclusions

References: Please confirm that every reference cited in the text of the poster is also present in the reference list.

Some tips on how to prepare your poster:

- Ensure that the core message is clear and understandable.
- Avoid long sentences.
- Present your conclusions in short bullet points.
- Avoid complex tables.
- Illustrate your results in graphs and flow charts.

How should you mount your poster? Upon arrival, please mount your poster in the Exhibition Hall. Each poster board has been assigned a number corresponding to the poster numbers listed in the program. Please locate your assigned board and mount your poster accordingly. Tacks and technical equipment will be available for mounting purposes.
